E' a valve with hoof to glass and pointed hood with red varnish (metalized creed under). It is not the E1F that is to ghianda. Someone of it knows something, has one outline or some data?

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I make excuses myself, the valve of the title it would have to be the E1R!!

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The E1R is similar, even if equivalent cannot in all defined being, to the ECH4. Salutes from gabbia33

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The E1R is the military version of the ECH4 differs for having the tubular dome covering anzichè.... creed is interchanging but I would have to verify....

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Thanks thousands. If someone had a schemino and some data on the several tensions would make a favor me to send it to me!

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The differences do not only consist in the aesthetic one. The not perfect interchangeability regards, as an example, the absorption of the filament, the absorption of the anodic one, the tension of polarization of grill etc. The piedinatura seems equal, and therefore also the filament tension and that anodic one; with a little fortune the ECH4 even works also... Salutes from gabbia33

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Based on my searches the E1R is identical to the ECH3 with the logons to the piedini equal to the ECH4.
